Camper & Staff COVID-19 Vaccination & Testing And Head Lice Check Policy

Updated March 1, 2023

For the safety of all our campers and staff, we recommend all campers and staff to be vaccinated for the COVID-19 virus, in accordance with the Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island Provincial Guidelines. If NS or PEI Provincial Health Offices issues new Guidelines for summer overnight camps, we will immediately update our Policies as required and post these updates on our websites and notify all Parents & Guardians who have already registered their children for our Camp this summer.

When Parents & Guardians are checking in and dropping off their Child at Camp we will take their Child's temperature and ask the standard COVID-19 questions, that all organizations now ask, before we allow their Child to stay at Camp. Furthermore, given that COVID-19 continues to be a public health issue our Camp may plan to conduct A Saliva or Nasal Swab Antigen Rapid Test of their Child which may also be required when Parents & Guardians check in / drop-off their Child and during the camping session. If our Camp does decide to conduct Antigen Rapid Testing for the COVID-19 virus, **by registering and allowing their children to attend our Camp, Parents & Guardians must consent and agree to our trained Camp staff conducting this Antigen Rapid Test on your Child.**

Families are also required to screen their campers (and person dropping the camper off) at home prior to leaving for participation in our overnight Camp using the [COVID-19 Daily Checklist](#).

Campers (and family member) who are showing signs and symptoms of COVID-19 OR any other flue like sickness or are unwell must NOT come to Camp, even if symptoms appear mild.

Parents and Guardians need to understand that in allowing their Child to come to Camp all of the above precautions does not preclude or prevent their Child from the possibility of getting COVID-19.

In addition to the Antigen Rapid Test a Head Lice Inspection will also be preformed by a Camp staff.

These health checks will take about 15 minutes. Please wait to have your child's checks completed and please do NOT leave the drop-off location. Once these health checks are completed we then have you finally sign your child into Camp.

If your child has the COVID-19 virus or Head Lice or the Flu or another contagious disease they will not be allowed to attend the camping session.
