

## Our Camp's Assistance In Taking a Common Over-The-Counter (OTC) Pain Relief Remedy Policy

During the camp week or a program activity your child may have mild pain or discomfort caused by such things as an upset stomach, indigestion or a headache or sore muscles and they may want a common over the counter remedy to relieve their discomfort. In the registration form Parents and Guardians will be asked to give permission for the Camp staff to assist their child in taking a child's dosage of a common Over-The-Counter pain relief medicine such as Aspirin (ASA - Acetylsalicylic Acid), or Tylenol (Acetaminophen) or Advil (Ibuprofen) or an anti-acid such as Pepto Bismol or Alka Seltzer, or their generic versions, to ease their pain and discomfort, should your child request such.
